Do you want to help the homeless in Broxbourne Borough? Would you consider helping at our Homeless Night Shelter on Saturday evenings or nights in **January and February 2019?**

- **Evening shift helper 7-10pm:** could you be one of the friendly people welcoming our homeless guests, coming alongside them, helping to set up beds in advance as well?
- **Overnight shift helper 10pm-7am:** you would be in a team of 6 people, and up in pairs for only 2 hours over night, with a bed to sleep on at all other times, to help make sure the guests are safe overnight. At 6am would be offering a simple breakfast and then packing the beds down.
- **Provide a pre-cooked evening meal for 20 people:** could you bring in a pre-cooked evening meal once during the January and February?
- **Venue Co-ordinator for our parish:** We will be one of seven churches in the borough hosting a night each week. Co-ordinating would involve putting together a rota of 12 people and helping to find individuals who could help with either the evening or overnight shift and find others to bring in a pre-cooked evening meal. We would ask that you are present for the evening shift around 7pm till 10pm. Whilst there will be time and effort involved, it promises to be an enormously rewarding and enjoyable experience. **You will be supported by Broxbourne Winter Night Shelter, Housing Justice and clergy** will be looking to support you in this role as well.
